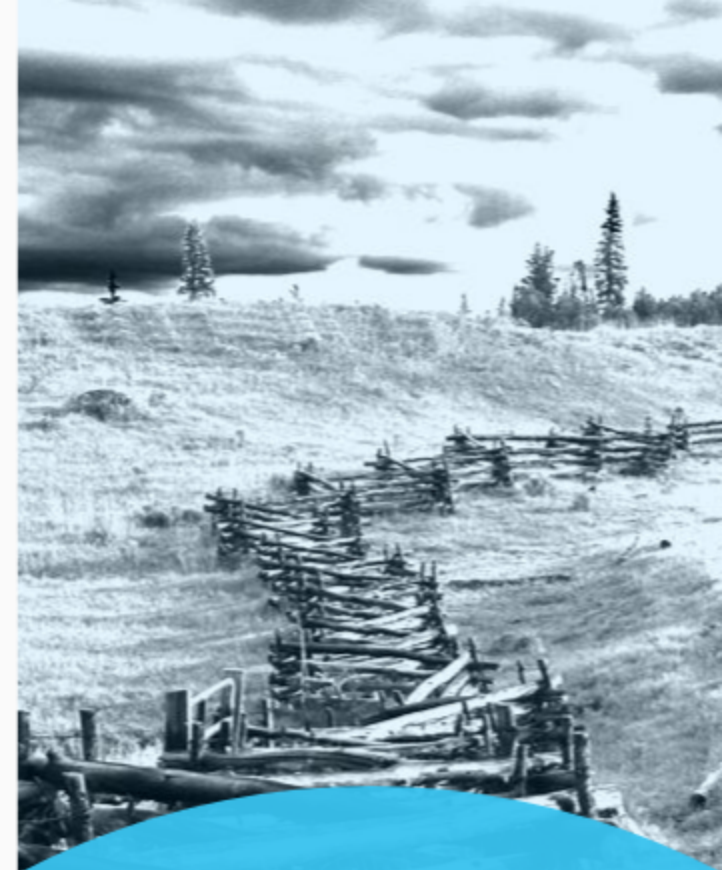


About the Presenter
